SUSRUTHA VOLUNTEERSHIP PROGRAMME

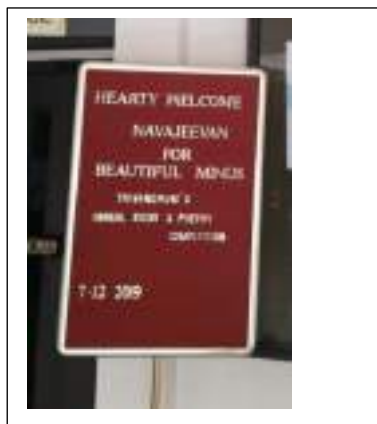
Bethanians attended a volunteership programme at Christian College Kattakada on 7th December. The team won the best selfie prize.

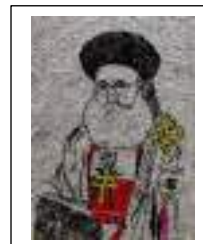






NAVANEETYAM ARTS EXHIBITION - 2019
